

YMCA Terms of Membership

- A 30 day advance written notice is required to cancel/terminate membership
- My membership payment is for one month in advance
- A target bank draft or credit card billing date is either the 10th or the 25th day of each month and it does not expire on the renewal date. A 30 day advance written request from you is required to terminate your membership entirely.
- Membership to the YMCA is a privilege, not a right, and the YMCA reserves the right to terminate my membership for behavior that is contrary to the character development traits of caring, honesty, respect and responsibility.
- I am required to bring my membership card and the card for each family member on each visit and present it to the front desk admission
- Appropriate dress consistent with a family atmosphere is a MUST! No excessively revealing clothes! Shoes and shirts are required at all times except while in the pool areas (swim trunks & appropriate swim wear is required in pool area).
- The YMCA conducts regular sex offender screenings on all members, participants, and guests. If a sex offender match occurs, the YMCA reserves the right to cancel membership, end program participation, and remove visitation access.
- I agree to obey all posted rules at the pool.
- I may be asked to provide a copy of my latest tax return as verification of family members.
- **Monthly or annual membership fees will not be refunded due to lack of facility use or any other reason.**
- The maximum number of children allowed in the nursery at one time is 15. The maximum length of stay is 2 hours. I must have a Family/Single Parent Family membership in order to use the Child Watch or Fun Club services
- On occasion, video tape or photographs may be taken of me or my family members during program participation and I agree to allow the use of such media materials for the express purpose of YMCA program promotion
- I acknowledge that I have been informed that the age limit to use the Fitness Center is 13 years. From the ages of 13-15 years old, the parent must be in the Fitness Center with the child.
- I will lock my car and valuables in the trunk. If I choose to bring valuables into the facility, I will bring my own lock to lock it up in my perspective locker, or rent a locker from the YMCA. Lockers are available for day use and must be cleaned out at the end of each day if not renting one. If items are left, they will be donated to charity. THE YMCA IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR LOST OR STOLEN ITEMS!
- I will use the age appropriate locker rooms. Unisex locker rooms in the pool hallway can be used with children ages 3months to 5 years. YOU MUST USE AGE APPROPRIATE LOCKERS!
- The joining fee is a non-refundable, one-time fee paid when I join. If I voluntarily cancel/terminate my membership, and decide to join over 6 months after leaving, I will be required to pay the joining fee again.
- I am able to place my membership on hold for up to 6 months. Medical conditions, maternity leave, leaving the area for a short time, would be cause for placing membership on hold. Paperwork will be required and proof of the above mentioned would be needed. Credit extension of membership will not be issued/granted for other reasons such as ("didn't come last month" etc) **MUST BE DONE BY THE 5TH OR 20TH TO EFFECT DRAFT.**
- As a member, I am able to bring out of town guest(s) for a fee of \$5 per person, per visit for an unlimited number of visits. I am able to bring only TWO local residents per unit at \$5 per person. If I bring more than 2 guests, the 3rd person and thereafter will be charged the day pass of \$15. After one visit, they must purchase a membership in order to continue to use the facility. GUEST REGISTRATION IS REQUIRED! ALL TERMS OF MEMBERSHIP ARE SUBJECT TO CHANGE!
- I WILL NOT USE MY CELL PHONE AT THE FRONT DESK, IN THE LOBBY AREA OR OTHER AREAS OF THE FACILITY. I WILL USE MY CELL PHONE OUTSIDE OF THE BUILDING AND LEAVE IT IN MY CAR. THE YMCA WILL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE LOST OR DAMAGE TO MY CELL PHONE!
